### What is Memorial Day and how is it different than Veterans Day

<u>Memorial Day</u>, which is observed on the last Monday in May, was originally set aside as a day for remembering and honoring military personnel who died in the service of their country, particularly those who died in battle or as a result of wounds sustained in battle.

Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971. Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades, often incorporating military personnel and members of veterans' organizations. Some people wear a red poppy in remembrance of those fallen in war.

<u>Veterans Day</u>, is intended to thank and honor all those who served honorably in the military—living and dead—whether in wartime or peace. In fact, Veterans Day is largely intended to thank living Veterans for their service, to acknowledge that their contributions to our national security are appreciated, and to underscore the fact that all those who served—not only those who died—have sacrificed and done their duty.

VFW Post 7865 will be hosting a Memorial Day ceremony around 1 PM on Memorial Day. Please join us to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our country and for all of us.





These are the opening words of Col. John McCrae's immortal poem dedicated to the memory of the men and women who served, fought and died in France during World War I, the Poppies of which he wrote have become the true symbol of all those who have given their lives in our nation's wars. The Poppy has become recognized as the memorial flower in countries throughout the world. It is distributed by veterans organizations in Europe, North America, and in most of the countries of the British Commowealth. Since 1922, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States has conducted an annual distribution of "Buddy" Poppies to raise funds for its charitable programs on behalf of the needy and disabled veterans, and the surviving family members of deceased veterans.




