With the 2024 Post summer project season now complete, we are starting back up our Gun raffles. This month we have a Mossberg over/under 12-gauge shotgun. We will only sell 100 tickets, when all the tickets are sold, we will draw the winner. Tickets are \$20 each. The money we raise from these raffles goes toward our building fund projects. Although we completed a lot of projects this year, we feel that we have a good start on updating and maintaining our Post for Veterans and members. Our mission with our Post is to update one or two things each year, then maintain with the best care we can.
